



MailOne for PostBase™ Release Notes

Version 3.1.0.0 – Released June 23, 2019

1. Dimensional Weighing has been implemented for Priority Mail® and Priority Express Mail® in compliance with the June 23, 2019 USPS® pricing change/rate change. Information about the change as well as support videos have been posted to the FP-USA website.
2. IMI postage meters, under USPS® requirements, cannot omit the date with the exception for “Reply Mail” purposes. In these instances, the date is omitted and the mail category code is reported to the postal service indicating that the mail piece is intended for Reply Mail. MailOne now has a checkbox within the Extra Service options so that Reply Mail can be selected for First-Class letters and large envelopes.
3. The Brother QL-1100 starter shipping labels are slightly larger than 4” x 6”. In order to support the non-standard size 4.07” x 6.4” (item #DK-1247), the print driver has been modified and these labels can now be printed.
4. Improvements/fixes:
 - a. Loading an address database with a few thousand addresses can take a long time upon startup. This has been changed to improve performance with larger address database sizes.
 - b. Selecting Extra Services for international products was not possible. This issue has been corrected.
 - c. Preselection of the Extra Service “USPS Tracking” when product selection was done through rate shopping does not work. This bug has been fixed.
